#### The Object of Rotary

THE OBJECT of Rotary is to encourage and foster the ideal of service as a basis of worthy enterprise and, in particular, to encourage and foster:

FIRST The development of acquaintance as an opportunity for service;

SECOND High ethical standards in business and professions, the recognition of the worthiness of all useful occupations, and the dignifying of each Rotarian's occupation as an opportunity to serve society;

THIRD The application of the ideal of service in each Rotarian's personal, business, and community life;

FOURTH The advancement of international understanding, goodwill, and peace through a world fellowship of business and professional persons united in the ideal of service

#### **The Four-Way Test**

- OF THE THINGS we think, say, or do:
- 1) Is it the TRUTH?
- 2) Is it FAIR to all concerned?
- 3) Will it build GOODWILL and BETTER FRIENDSHIPS?
- 4) Will it be BENEFICIAL to all concerned?

#### **Rotarian Code of Conduct**

The following code of conduct has been adopted for the use of Rotarians:

#### AS A ROTARIAN, I will

- 1) Act with integrity and high ethical standards in my personal and professional life
- 2) Deal fairly with others and treat them and their occupations with respect
- 3) Use my professional skills through Rotary to: mentor young people, help those with special needs, and improve people's quality of life in my community and in the world
- 4) Avoid behavior that reflects adversely on Rotary or other Rotarians

2. During the quarantine period, our dues, assessments, luncheon costs, etc., will continue as if we were functioning as usual. Any savings as a result of not incurring luncheon costs at Lawry's, etc., will be added to our community service budget. Any club member adversely impacted by the quarantine may contact Pres. Sean privately and request adjustment.

3. The Gold Raffle date has been changed to June 25, 2020, at the same location.

4. Because the Gold Raffle is so close to the scheduled June 29<sup>th</sup> debunking, there is a possibility that the debunking may be postponed. Decision to follow at a later date.

5. The Happy Feet program has been cancelled for the remainder of our Rotary calendar year. Available funds will be redirected to help our community during the COVID-19 crisis.

6. "Feed the Homeless" on 4/29/20 is cancelled.

7. A donation of \$2,500 was approved to Nevada Partnership for Homeless Youth.

8. A donation of \$2,500 was approved to the Nevada Homeless Alliance to help in their placement of corona virus-vulnerable homeless in motel rooms.

9. The next Zoom meeting would be held on April 1, 2020, and the entire club will be invited to attend.

On April 1, 2020, the board met and made the following decisions:

1. We will hold a "virtual" meeting for our social on our regularly scheduled date of 4/23/20 at 6:00 p.m. The meeting will be held via Zoom and the program will be "What are you doing to survive the pandemic?" Each attendee will have a chance to take a minute or two.

2. There will be a Zoom board of directors meeting on May 11, 2020.

3. The scholarship application deadline is extended to May 15, 2020.

4. Because it is still uncertain about when the Governor's business shutdown order may be lifted, we have tentatively cancelled the in-person meetings during May also. If the shutdown is still in place in May, we will have a virtual social evening on May  $21^{st}$ . At the social meeting on 4/23, we will "take the temperature" (no pun intended) of the situation at that time.
