Melissa Brooks brought a hand carved wood bottle opener from her visit to Belize in Central America:




Ron Reynolds said they were just in New York and brought back a New York pin. He said they also attended a Broadway play "Six" while they were there:








PROGRAM

Fred Fukumoto, who heads up the Scholarship Committee introduced our program with the following introduction:

Rotary International is a global network of 1.4 million neighbors, friends, leaders and problem solvers dedicated to "Service above Self. Rotary members belong to one of 46,000 clubs that are part of 529 districts. Las Vegas Southwest Rotary belongs to District 5300.

Your Vocational Service was helped by the following Club members this year: Angela Baker, Melissa Brooks, Eric Colvin, Adrienne Cox, Angela Domingo, Francesca Gilbert, Lester Kaneta, Troy Lochhead, Jeanne Radde, and Joe Wittenwiler. If any of you are present today, please stand so that the Club can applaud you for your service.

When **President Paul's** year began, he had a goal of being the Rotary club to youth. I think that he accomplished that goal. In Vocational Service, we sponsored 4 students to Teen Leadership Camp ("TLC") in December 2022. TLC is a 3 day event where students are grouped into teams of 8 (no 2 students are from the same school and usually not from the same city) and stay in this team for the entire 3 day event. During that time, they hear from motivational speakers and work together to solve common problems. Several of our members have children or children of friends that attended and speak very highly of what their experience at this camp.

The Club also sponsored 4 students to Rotary Youth Leadership Awards ("RYLA") that was scheduled for March 2023 in the mountains of Southern California. This camp is for high school sophomores and juniors but due to the extreme snow this past winter the event was not held. One of our members, **Eric Colvin**, is a graduate of a past RYLA as well as several children of current members, including myself. The Club will continue to support RYLA in the future.

Rotary members live their lives by Rotary's Four-Way test which says "of the things we think, say or do - first is it the Truth?; second- is it fair to all concerned?; third, will it built goodwill and better friendships; and fourth, will it be beneficial to all concerned." In order to transfer the principles of this test to high school students, District 5300 holds an annual speech contest open to all high school students. Students compete first at the Club level, next at an area competition, then a regional competition culminating in a final competition at the Annual District 5300 Conference. The winner at the District level is awarded a \$5,000 scholarship.

District 5300 had a benefactor who believed that music is as important as speech and started the Dan Stover music awards which is open to all high school students. The competition is the same as for the Four Way speech contest with this winner at the District level being awarded a \$3,000 scholarship. Finally, the Club's greatest award to students is its Annual Scholarship. This Scholarship has been awarded for over 45 years and rewards the chosen student with \$1,200 per semester towards their college education as long as they maintain a 3.0 GPA taking at least 12 semester hours. I have been blessed to be apart of the scholarship committee for many years.

A few years ago, a long time past member of this Club, donated funds from his estate to help fund part of the annual scholarship costs. The Club renamed the Scholarship "The Las Vegas Southwest Rotary Club John and Lou Yoxen Memorial Scholarship". John Yoxen was a long time masonry contractor and instrumental in bringing Pioneer Bank (now part of Nevada State Bank) to Las Vegas from Reno.

The Club is pleased to be able to award 2 scholarships this year. **Joyce Calimag**, a graduate of Cristo Rey school and **Malorie Schwartz**, a graduate of Southwest Career & Technical Academy. I'd like to ask both of them to join me here and tell you a little about themselves and where they will be continuing their education. If you have any questions of our scholarship winner, please ask them now. Please join me in applauding their great high school experience.

Now I'd like to ask a previous scholarship winner, **Vicky Wang**, to join me to give you an update on her last semester and career plans. As part of the Club's scholarship, each of these young ladies has been paired with a Club Rotarian; **Lester and Marian Kaneta** are **Joyce's** mentors, **Adrienne Cox** is **Malorie's** and I have been **Vicky's** contact to the Club. I hope that I have explained the Club's Vocational avenue of service. That concludes my part of this meeting.

Malorie said that she plans to attend UNR and study broadcast journalism and hopes to be "on screen" She is a video gamer and likes dogs and is involved with her church at The Crossings.

Joyce graduated as Salutatorian and will be attending UNLV to study for a social work degree with hopes of perhaps becoming a neuropsychiatrist.

Vicky is now a Junior at UNLV studying for a biology degree in the pre-dental program. She is already working at Town and Country Dental as a summer dental assistant and in August will be taking the dental admissions test.
