He also hosts and produces the studio show “The Catch” and various live events. He is also the play-by-play Broadcaster for UNLV Baseball and select UNLV Football, Men’s and Women’s Basketball games on the Silver State Sports Entertainment Network and Mountain West Network

He was previously the broadcaster for the Bradenton Marauders (Pirates Advanced-A) for two seasons and has been a Broadcast Booth Assistant for the Boston Red Sox. Before then he was the media relations manager for the Birmingham Barons (White Sox Double-A).

He is a graduate of Appalachian State University with a Bachelor of Arts in Electronic Media and Broadcasting. He also played Division 3 baseball for two seasons while serving as the team's representative on the Student Athlete Advisory Committee.



He comes by broadcasting naturally as his father is a broadcaster with the Los Angeles Dodgers.
