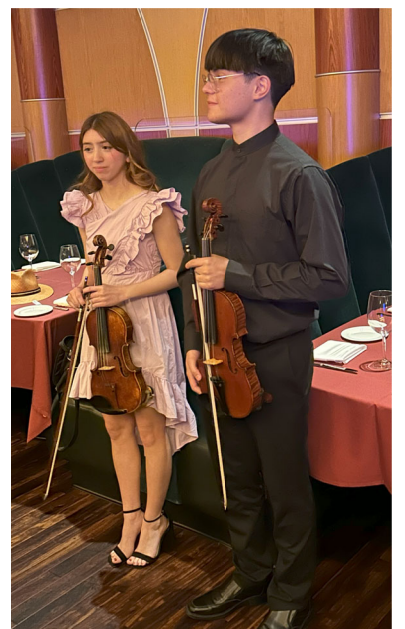

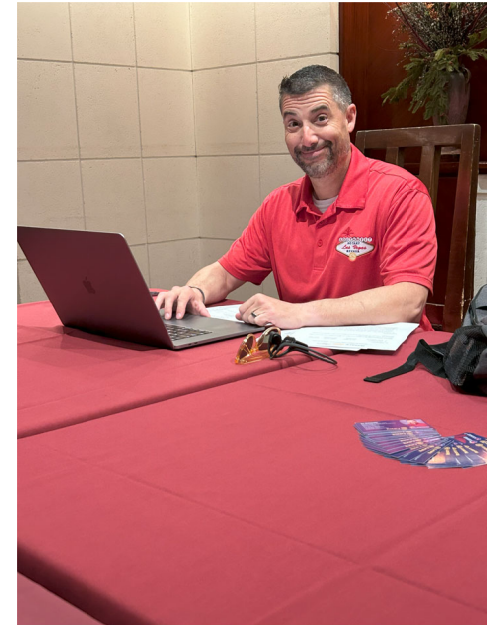
LET'S WELCOME BRUCE TO THE BEST CLUB IN DISTRICT 5300.
