Today's speaker was our **Jody Baden**, Founder and CEO of Transparency in Politics.

Jody Baden arrived in Reno in 1995, from Florida and quickly fell in love with the Silver State. After several years of involvement with her former husband's dental practice and volunteering with McQueen High School, Jody ran for Washoe County School Board. She was more than surprised to learn how easy it was to be on the ballot-show an ID and write a check!



Jody was elected to the School Board and served two terms. At the time, she was Jody Ruggiero and served on the Board with several fine people including Lezlie Porter. It was during these years that she started the nonprofit, Tune in to Kids, which turned into a family event that drew 12,000 kids and parents to Idlewild Park for non-screen fun.

In 2010, she returned to Florida to care for her aging parents. After twelve years of working in the family business, she was ready to return to Nevada. In 2022, she returned to Reno and is happy to be back. Her new business, Transparency in Politics, was started because "someone had to do it." And "Why do over 90% of employers require some sort of background check and it's almost never required to run for public office?" Jody wants to create a movement to normalize background checks for political candidates. Transparency is everything. "Democracy dies in darkness."
