

PROGRAM

Sean Tanko, Southwest Rotarian extraordinaire and past-President (2019-2020) was our speaker today. He practices estate law as "The Law Office of Sean Tanko Limited". For nearly 20 years, he has advised residents of Las Vegas and all of Nevada on estate planning and probate matters (Wills & Trusts).

He began with some insights into his family of five brothers. He said they were raised by a single mother who, while starting out as a nurse anesthetist, decided to go to law school graduating at the same time that **Sean** graduated from high school. He was raised in Omaha, Nebraska, was Jesuit raised and went to Creighton University.

After practicing bankruptcy law for a year or so in Omaha (and not liking it at all), he decided to join his younger brother, **Brian**, who was practicing estate planning law in Las Vegas. **Brian's** constitutional law professor had recommended that he move to Las Vegas. In 2002, **Sean** moved to Las Vegas and practiced law with his brother for 7 years. **Brian**, however, had it in his mind that he wanted to live in Montana so he moved north and is enjoying a successful practice there.

His middle brother is a retired Coast Guard Major and is currently a hydrologist with the Department of the Interior.

His brother **Jason** (who **Sean** said had an early fascination with streetlights going to far as to have a full-blown street light over his dorm room bed when he was in college in Seattle) now has a company that retrofits street lights, etc., with LED lights for counties and cities all over the states west of the Mississippi. **Sean** said **Jason** spends a fair amount of time fending off offers from the big companies who are trying to buy him out and eliminate the competition.

His brother **Quentin** is a trauma orthopedic surgeon in Ocala, Florida.

He said he and his brothers are all very close and get together every year for Thanksgiving. There is only 7 years from the oldest to the youngest and **Sean** said that he and **Brian** are "Irish twins".

Sean talked about the independent administration process related to probate that has been much in the news lately particularly with the murder of **Jeff German** who was investigating the Clark County Public Administrator.

He spoke also about the probate process, saying that there are over 10,000 probate cases filed a year.

He also spoke about a client of his that recently passed away and who had designated LVSWR as a 50% beneficiary in his estate planning documents. The client was a single man who had worked in human resources at the test site and who had no heirs. The estate is still in the process of winding up and funds should be distributed in a couple of months.
