






Greg Mottau spent some time in Sedona, AZ again with some friends and brought back a couple of postcards and an advertisement showing how inexpensive the houses are in that area.


Don Logan, President/COO of the <u>Las Vegas Aviators</u> was our speaker today. He was introduced by Southwest Rotarian **Bruce Pope**, who is a longtime friend. Bruce took the opportunity to announce that he and **Beth** are selling their house and moving to the "<u>Las Ventanas Retirement Community</u>" in Summerlin.

Don has spoken to our club on previous occasions and his presentations are always informative, delightful, and professional. The Aviators are a




class act and so is **Don.** We appreciate his willingness to come to our club and share what is happening with the Aviators. We also appreciated the fact that he not only brought a bunch of Aviator baseball caps but also brought a "goody bag"

for the Gold Raffle which he presented to Rebecca Collett.



Las Vegas' two Pacific Coast League championship teams (1986, 1988).



During his tenure, he has earned respect not only as one of the most influential sports executives in Las Vegas, but in all of professional baseball. That respect has been recognized with countless honors, most notably as the first and only three-time





winner of the Pacific Coast League's Executive of the Year award (1992, 1998, 2018). He is also a two-time recipient of the Larry McPhail Promotional Trophy (1991, 1997), and in December 2019, he was named Baseball America Minor League Executive of the Year. He has also served as the PCL's Vice President and on the Joint Minor League Baseball Marketing Committee. As a one-time chairman of the PCL's Executive Committee, Logan oversaw league operations and later served on the advisory board of PCL President Branch Rickey III. The Aviators franchise, on December 2, 2021, was the recipient of the Baseball America Triple-A Bob Freitas Award. The Freitas award is given annually to the organization of the year at each level of the Minor Leagues.

Under **Don's** guidance and in partnership with the Las Vegas Convention and Visitors Authority (LVCVA), the Las Vegas franchise has hosted dozens of Major League Baseball spring training games at Cashman Field and Las Vegas Ballpark. These "Big League Weekend" games have featured such Hall of Fame

players as Las Vegas native Greg Maddux, Ken Griffey Jr. and the late Tony Gwynn, as well as perennial All-Stars Barry Bonds, Alex Rodriguez, Ichiro Suzuki, Sandy Alomar Jr. and Matt Kemp, to name a few. In part because of Big League Weekend's success, the Oakland A's elected to play their first six games of the 1996 season at Cashman Field, while their home stadium (the Oakland Alameda County Coliseum) was completing renovations.

He also was instrumental in bringing the Triple-A World Series to Cashman Field for three years (1998-2000), pitting the PCL champion against International League champion. He then worked with the MLB Players Association to host the "Big League Home Run Challenge" at Cashman Field. The nationally televised event (ESPN, ESPN2) took place each February from 2000-03.

Despite a busy schedule, **Don** has found time to support many community projects, including serving on

the Executive Committee of both the Las Vegas Bowl and Southern Nevada Sports Hall of Fame. Among the honors he's received for his community work include: the 2007 Chin's Humanitarian of the Year for the Muscular Dystrophy Association of Southern Nevada; 2010 ESPN Sportsman of the Year, benefitting The Caring Place, a local nonprofit dedicated to easing the journey of those affected by cancer; 2018 Nevada Broadcasters Association and Foundation Community Achievement Award; and 2018 Free Enterprise Award presented by the Las Vegas Metro Chamber of Commerce to those who personify the entrepreneurial spirit and commitment to free enterprise in Southern Nevada and across the entire state.

In conjunction with the Howard Hughes Corporation, he in October 2017 secured a naming-rights deal with the LVCVA for Las Vegas Ballpark, a new state-of-the-art Triple-A baseball stadium in Downtown Summerlin. After working for two decades to make the stadium a reality, Logan finally ushered in a new era for




professional baseball in Southern Nevada when Las Vegas Ballpark broke ground February 23, 2018. The venue officially opened its doors April 9, 2019, welcoming a sellout crowd of 11,036, and the Aviators would go on to lead all of Minor League Baseball in attendance in 2019.

A 1981 graduate of Utah State and 2011 inductee into the Southern Nevada Sports Hall of Fame, **Don** has been married to his wife, **Jennifer**, for 25 years. He has one daughter, **Adrienne**. His daughter is married to **Ryan Fitzgerald** and they reside in Reno.
