

**Bailie Schauer,** Community Outreach Specialist, FBI Las Vegas Division was our speaker today. She was accompanied by **Sandy Breault,** the Public Affairs Officer for the Las Vegas Division.

**Bailie** was born in Las Vegas, Nevada and has lived in Henderson for the majority of her life. She earned her degree in Neuroscience from the University of Nevada, Reno. While she attended UNR, she was an Honors Intern with the FBI, working in the Las Vegas Field Office, Reno Resident Agency, and Phoenix Field Office in their Counterterrorism sections. After graduating a semester early, she moved back to Las Vegas and began her full-time career with the bureau.

Starting full-time as an Operational Support Technician in the Las Vegas Field Office in 2020, **Bailie** worked in the Operations Center, directing phone calls from the public and running NCIC checks. After about a year, she became the Multimedia Specialist, the first person to hold that position in the bureau. She worked closely with the Public Affairs Specialist and Community Outreach Specialist to assist with graphic design and videography projects.



In June of 2024, she began her new role as one of the Community Outreach Specialists, managing all the outreach programs for the FBI in Nevada.

**Sandy** is a native of Pennsylvania and spend 30 years with the Omaha FBI officer before transferring her 7 ½ years ago. She said her dad was a Rotarian and they spent many years hosting exchange students in their home.



We concluded with the 4-Way Test conducted by Pres. Rebecca.

























# Las Vegas Field Office Organizational Chart




# Las Vegas Field Office Area of Responsibility
