Karl Maisner introduced today's speaker, **Heather Engle**, CEO of the [Las Vegas Rescue Mission](#) (as you may or may not know, each of our speakers this past year has been recognized with a donation made to the LVRM on the speaker's behalf.) When you click on the link in the first sentence and scroll to the bottom of the page, you will see that their website was created by none other than **Karl!**

Heather is a native Nevadan, born in Elko, raised in Carson City, and educated at UNR. She has been CEO at LVRM for 7 ½ years.

As a nonprofit Christian organization, the Mission receives no government support, except for a small grant specifically for food. They rely solely upon the contributions and support of concerned individuals, churches, corporations and other organizations. The Mission provides

services to all people without regard to race, color, creed, national origin, age, gender, religion or disability.

Founded in 1970, the Las Vegas Rescue Mission (LVRM) started with a small storefront building that included the chapel, kitchen and a shelter that could house a few men. Today, LVRM campus takes up two city blocks in downtown Las Vegas, helping hundreds of men, women and their children daily, and provides approximately 30,000 meals each month.

She spoke about the current efforts regarding their organization (see attached) and their capital campaign (also attached).

They have volunteer shifts for their Community Dinner Service, Thrift Store Warehouse, and more. Individuals and groups are welcome. If

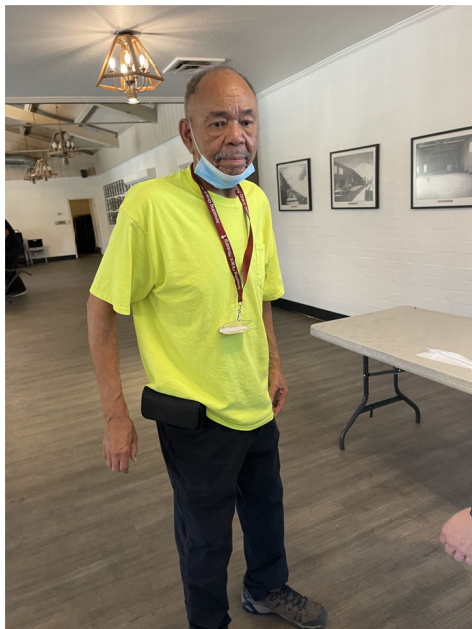

- ▶ The Las Vegas Rescue Mission exists to serve those in need through food, shelter, daily needs and addiction recovery, offering hope to individuals and families through Jesus Christ.
- ▶ Founded in 1970; started as small storefront offering food
- ▶ We are a Christian Ministry and pride ourselves on helping any and all who need it
- ▶ Primarily community / private funded

FEEDING THOSE IN NEED
