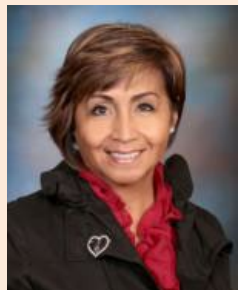

4. **Rotary 4-Way Speech Contest** – open to all high school students who write a speech using the 4-Way test and this year's Rotary theme of Unite for Good. The speech needs to be at least 6 minutes but not longer than 8 minutes. This year's contest will be held on January 12, 2026. If you have children who are interested, please contact Fred Fukumoto.
5. **Dan Stover Music Contest** – open to all high school students who will perform at the Club on February 9, 2026. If you have children who are interested, please contact Jeanne Radde. And finally,
