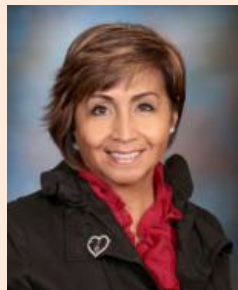

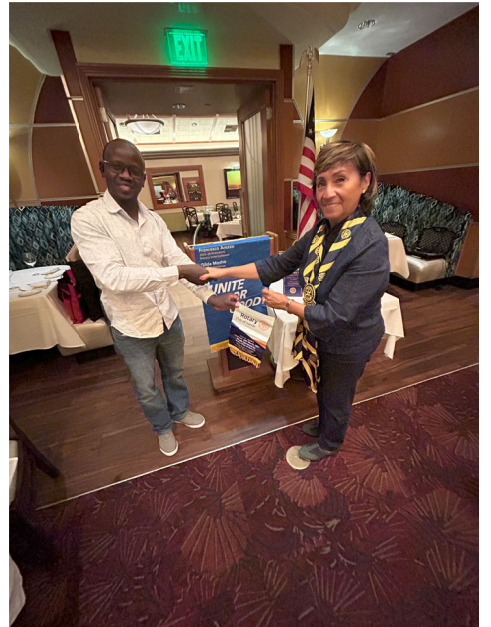

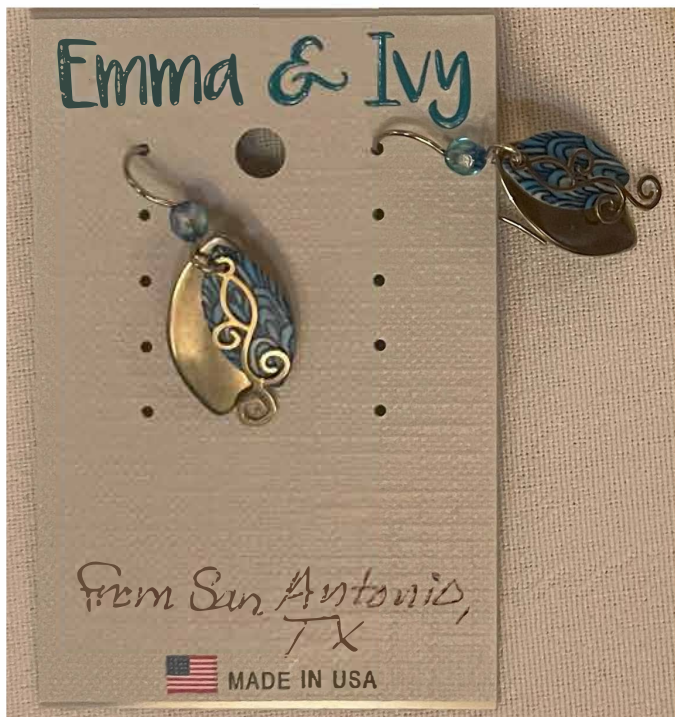

1. INSTRUCTION & FACILITATION – \$1,200

- Chef instructor stipends: $\$100 \times 12 \text{ weeks} = \$1,200$

Why: Stipend for gas

2. INGREDIENTS & COOKING SUPPLIES – \$1,800

- Weekly groceries for 20 students: $\$300 \times 6 \text{ weeks} = \1800
- Cooking supplies, utensils, disposable containers

Why: Ensures hands-on cooking with fresh, nutritious ingredients.

3. CERTIFICATIONS & CREDENTIALS – \$1,600

- Certifications: $\$80 \times 20 = \1600

Why: Workforce-ready credentials beyond college credit.

4. COLLEGE CREDIT & ACCREDITATION FEES – \$1,200

- CTE credit: $\$60 \times 20 = \$1,200$

Why: Guarantees participants receive 2-3 accredited credits for completion.

5. FACILITIES & INSURANCE – \$800

- Facility/insurance contingency = \$800

Why: Covers liability and ensures program access to facilities.

6. PROGRAM MATERIALS & STARTER KITS – \$1,300

- Chef apron + knife set + binder: $\$65 \times 20 = \$1,300$

Why: Youth leave with tangible tools to keep cooking at home.

7. GRADUATION & COMMUNITY PROJECT – \$1,300

- Week 11 service meal ingredients = \$800
- Week 12 graduation ceremony (certificates, food, decorations) = \$500

Why: Celebrates youth achievements, includes family/community.

8. MARKETING & OUTREACH – \$300

- Flyers, printing, social media ads, outreach materials = \$300

Why: Recruiting foster youth and volunteers requires visibility.

9. GENERAL SUPPORT / ADDITIONAL YOUTH – \$500

Why: Program support & coordination or additional youth signup
