
#### ROTARIAN CODE OF CONDUCT

He said that the focus at the chamber is to 1. Empower foster youth 16-24, and 2. To support those who support foster youth. One of their major programs is the "Culinary Path to Life" program, which among other things, presents healthier alternatives to today's fast-food diet.

# 5. FACILITIES & INSURANCE - \$800
