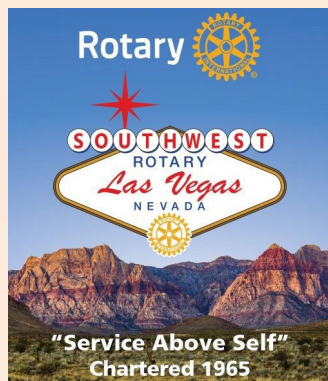

Our program today was presented by **Erin Breen** following up on her presentation on June 9th where she introduced our club to her work at UNLV. She serves as director of UNLV's Road Equity Alliance Project. She is also the coordinator of the UNLV Transportation Research Center's Traffic Safety Coalition.

She specializes in traffic and pedestrian safety, bringing research and awareness for state policymakers on the issues of drunk and distracted driving, jaywalking, and more. After experiencing personal tragedy when her daughter survived a preventable car accident, she began researching ways to increase traffic safety awareness for new and reckless drivers throughout Southern Nevada. She has since been a key player in lobbying driving laws, such as Nevada's graduated driving law — a restriction for teenage motorists that has dramatically dropped the number of underage driving deaths.



She also actively works with Silver State municipalities to promote pedestrian and driving safety education for student commuters.

A couple of big takeaways from her presentation...DON'T GIVE YOUR KIDS AN E-SCOOTER AND THE LAW IN CLARK COUNTY IS THAT ANYONE UNDER 18 HAS TO WEAR A HELMET ON ANY MOTORIZED DEVICE.
