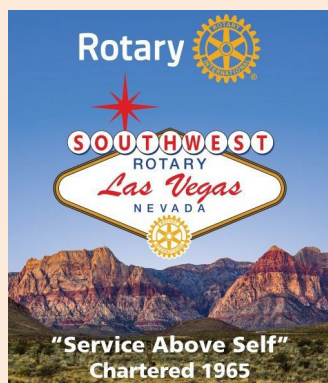

Our program today was presented by **Wen Chen**. She was born in China at the end of the Great Cultural Revolution.



Being victims of the horrific atrocity that killed two million intellectuals and destroyed traditional Chinese culture, **Wen's** parents had mixed feelings about her education. Despite their discouragement, **Wen** eventually won a national prize at a science competition when she was 16. Hence, she was accepted into a top university for undergraduate study.

In 1994, **Wen** came to the U.S. for graduate school and received a doctorate in Biology at the California Institute of Technology in 2000. Because of her personal experience of being brainwashed in China, she decided to be a voice for the voiceless.

Since 2012, she has given hundreds of presentations to community organizations about Chinese culture, history, and human rights.

Wen has been working as a scientific staff member for Caltech since 2000.

Since 2012, she has given hundreds of presentations to community organizations about Chinese culture, history, and society.

Wen has been working for Caltech since 2000 as a biologist and information scientist. Her everyday work includes scientific outreach by speaking at conferences and seminars at universities. In her personal life, she is an activist for human rights in China. She also serves as a board member and community liaison for Caltech Women in Biology and Biological Engineering. Chinese Medicine and Meditation

Chinese medicine has a deep root in Taoism theories regarding the human body as a miniature universe. Ancient Chinese believed that the prevention of getting ill is more critical than any cure. A healthy lifestyle includes eating the right food. Food is also the primary source of medicine when one is sick. There is a very long history of meditation in China to keep people calm and give them wisdom. Audiences will hear legends about ancient Chinese doctors. We will discuss how these wise people integrated traditional values into their practice to cure individuals and positively impact society.

their spiritual beliefs or political views. These prisoners of conscience have been tortured, forced to do slave labor, and killed for their organs. While it takes several years in the U.S. to wait for matching organs, most Chinese hospitals promise to find donors within weeks. The Chinese police, legal, and military systems collaborated to perform the state-sanctioned forced organ harvesting. The audience will also hear about the Chinese Communist Party's infiltration into the U.S., the human rights movement in China, an innovation that allows people to bypass China's Internet blockade, and the trend of quitting the Chinese Communist Party.

Human Rights Movement in China

The Chinese authorities arrested millions of citizens for

Traditional Chinese Attire

Ancient China was called “a country of etiquette.” The oldest piece of silk cloth found dates to roughly 3630 B.C. Every Dynasty had different clothes and accessories, which reflected the lifestyle and philosophy at that time. Through ancient Chinese paintings and sculptures, audiences will learn the origin and unique features of traditional Chinese attire and a brief overview of styles from different dynasties or ethnic groups.

The Science of Tea Making

Tea, discovered in China at ~2700 B.C. as a herb, is now a popular drink worldwide. Tea masters played every step of the elaborate tea-making process, from tree harvest to a cup to produce different flavors. The Tang Dynasty (7th - 10th century) was the turning point for tea to become a daily drink instead of medicine; hence it started tea ceremonies among the royal courts, temples, and intellectuals. Numerous poets and art pieces from ancient China are associated with tea. The tea culture evolved from dynasty to dynasty, leading to more and more varieties that we see today. Audiences will also learn how ancient Chinese invented different kinds of tea, the best way to brew them, and their medical benefits.

The Renaissance of Chinese Culture

Chinese wisdom and traditions have been passed down for over 5,000 years and are regarded as gifts from the heavens. But the Chinese Communist Party has nearly destroyed this rich, traditional culture during the past 60 years. The loss of traditional beliefs and moral foundations caused a crisis at social, political, and economic levels. More and more people long for a renaissance of the traditional culture. One manifestation of this is Shen Yun Performing Arts from New York. Through exceptional dance skills, fascinating stories and legends, breathtaking backdrops, a live orchestra that combines Western and Chinese musical instruments, and hundreds of richly colored costumes, Shen Yun brings China's traditional values to life.

China's Global Impact

The Chinese Communist Party (CCP) quickly gained financial power after China joined the World Trade Organization. During the past 20 years, the Chinese government built up business ties with Hollywood and over 30 mainstream media worldwide to tell a better story about China. Hundreds of universities, including the college board, outsourced Mandarin teaching to the Chinese government. The Chinese consulates actively manipulate Chinese Americans and business owners who may steal intellectual property or influence elections. The U.S. lawmakers cannot stop at "condemning human rights abuses in China." They must take serious actions to prevent American businesses from sponsoring the CCP. We also need serious measures to protect academic and press freedom.

North Korea and China

For over 60 years, China has been supporting its communist neighbors and keeping an ally to resist the society of freedom. China has been funding the Kim regime by contributing to 90% of North Korea's export income, providing material and technology for North Korea's nuclear power behind the scenes, and sending refugees back to North Korean concentration camps. At the same time, the Chinese regime uses North Korea as a bargaining chip with the U.S., claiming that China is the only one that can bring North Korea to the table. An in-depth analysis of the influence of the Chinese government in the world is essential for us to understand the current U.S.-China relationship.

Coronavirus and China's Censorship

The spread of coronavirus raised worldwide attention to China's epidemics and public health policy. The Chinese authority deliberately hid the contagious fact of the coronavirus for three weeks by punishing medical doctors who disclosed the information on social media. While denying the association between the virus and the Wuhan Institute of Virology, China introduced its first biosafety law on Feb. 17, 2020, then shifted the blame to the U.S. military. Understanding the profound reason behind the Communist Party's disaster response is crucial for us to expect its consequences and shape future U.S.-China policies.

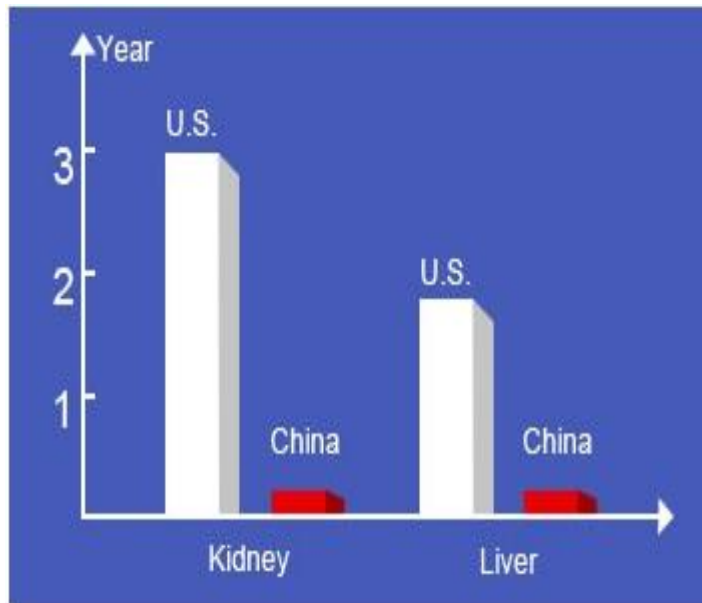

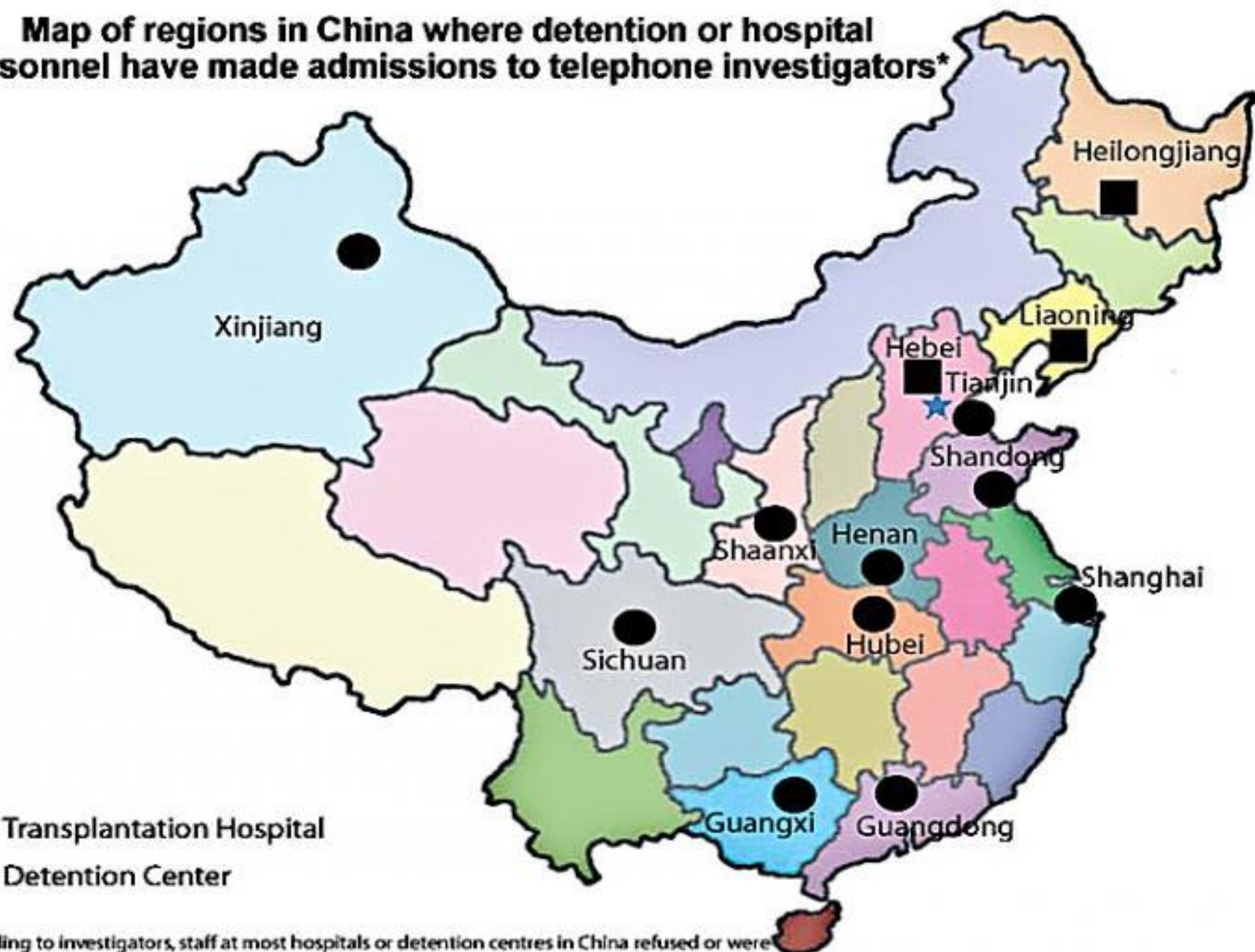

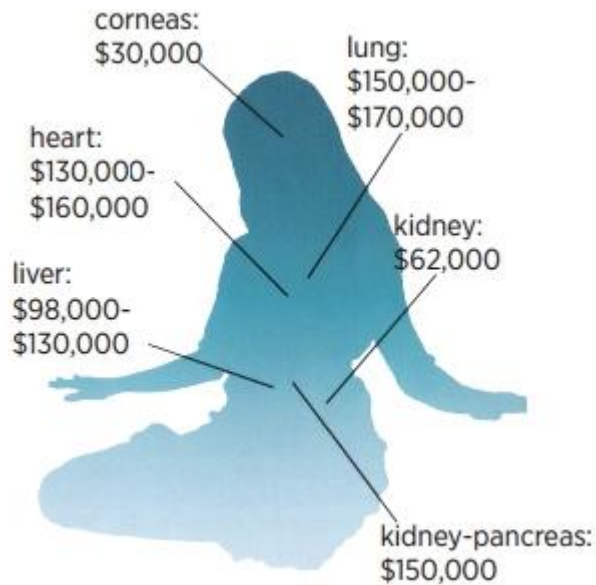

Rotary Satellite Club of Ending Forced Organ Harvesting: Our Story

In 2018, a booth from HOF (House of Friendship) at the RI Convention in Toronto with the name of “End Organ Trafficking Now” caught Rotarian Shirley Hu’s attention. People at the booth were distributing flyers about forced organ harvesting - a crime against humanity that has been going on for more than 20 years. Traveling from halfway around the world, these booth exhibitors belonged to an NGO, TAICOT (Taiwan Association for International Care of Organ Transplant).

Shirley was inspired by the group and was surprised she couldn’t find any Rotarians who were involved or aware of this significant initiative.

In 2019, on behalf of Plano Metro Rotary club, she was able to organize a booth of “Ending Forced Organ Trafficking - Time to Act Now” at the RI Convention in Germany in partnership with TAICOT. More than 1,000 flyers and petitions were distributed; 550 Rotarians signatures were collected in support of the initiative. 59 banners were received from Rotary clubs worldwide. Clearly, she was on to something that struck a nerve with fellow Rotarians!





In 2022, with the proactive support from the RAGAS Chair Dave McCleary, Shirley recruited a group of four volunteers to help distribute flyers raising awareness of FOH (Forced Organ Harvesting) at the RAGAS booth at the Houston Convention. Crystal Chen was one of them.
