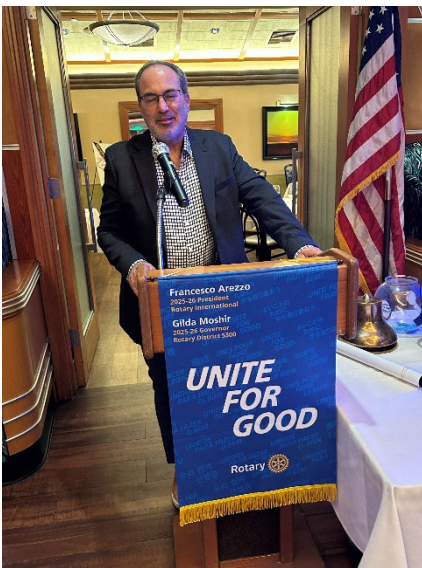
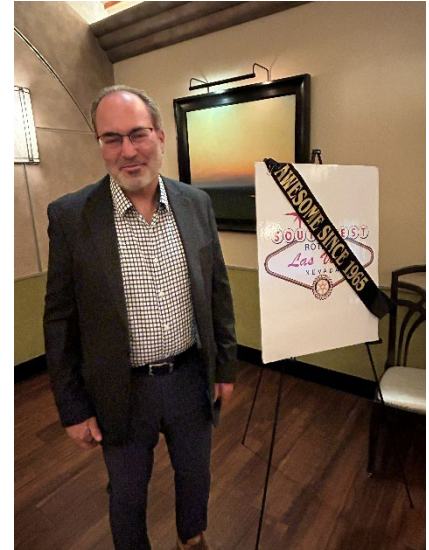

PROGRAM

Eric Colvin introduced today's speaker **Jon Ralston**. **Jon** recently completed a book about the life of the late Senator Harry Reid. The book, "The Game Changer: How Harry Reid Remade the Rules and Showed Democrats How to Fight" was published by Simon & Schuster and is available just about everywhere.

Here is an introduction from Publishers Weekly: "Former Senate majority leader Harry Reid was a ruthless political operator who embodied the Democratic Party's journey leftward, according to this incisive debut biography. Journalist Ralston recaps Reid's Dickensian boyhood in Searchlight, Nev., where he grew up in a shack made of railroad ties and chicken wire. A law career and rise in local politics ensued, including a dramatic stint as chairman of the Nevada Gaming Commission, where he wrangled with a mobbed-up casino industry. (He helped the FBI nail a corrupt slot-machine impresario—"You tried to bribe me, you son of a bitch," he yelled while choking the perp—after which his wife found a bomb in their car.) Reid's reign as Majority Leader, from 2007 to 2015 was marked by assiduous relationship-building, occasional smear campaigns—he falsely told reporters that Mitt Romney had not paid taxes for 10 years—and canny horse trading. Reid often put power over principle, Ralston observes, as when he pushed to weaken the filibuster in 2013 after opposing that measure when Republicans proposed it. Reid's evolving policy stances reflect the Democrats' shift leftward, Ralston argues, noting that, early on, Reid supported a right-to-life amendment, opposed measures protecting gay people from discrimination, and even proposed abolishing birthright citizenship. Ralston paints Reid as, above all, wryly self-aware of his own willingness to bend his principles to make progress. **It's an insightful, entertaining portrait.**"



Jon has been covering politics in Nevada for more than 30 years. His blog, Ralston Reports, was founded in 2012 and now lives on The Nevada Independent website. **Jon** wrote for the Las Vegas Review-Journal for 15 years, the last seven as a freelance columnist. In 1999, Greenspun Media Group purchased his political newsletter, The Ralston Report, and hired him as a columnist for the Las Vegas Sun where his byline appeared until September 2012. He was also a columnist for the Reno Gazette-Journal from January 2015 until November 2016, when he left to start The Indy.

Over the years, **Jon** has hosted several TV programs, including "Ralston Live" on Vegas PBS and "Ralston Reports" on KSNV News 3. He also writes and publishes a Nevada-centric email newsletter called "Flash" that frames the political agenda for the day, breaks news and offers analysis and snark. In 2012, Politico named **Jon** one of the Top 50 "Politicos to Watch." He frequently appears on MSNBC, FOX News, and PBS, and he has also appeared on NBC's long-running "Meet the Press."

Jon is originally from Buffalo, New York. He has a B.A. in English from Cornell University and a M.A. in journalism from University of Michigan. He came to Las Vegas in 1984 as the night police reporter for the Las Vegas Review-Journal, later covering general assignment and county government before becoming a political reporter in 1986. He has a son, **Jake. Jon** loves movies and movie trivia and aspires to one day be The Nevada Independent's film critic, if they'll let him.

Jon is a frequent speaker at our club and is always informative and entertaining. Once again, we ran out of time for questions and look forward to having him back again in the future.
