Eric Colvin introduced our speaker today, **Virginia Valentine, P.E., President & CEO, Nevada Resort Association (NRA)**.

She is the President/CEO of the Nevada Resort Association. The NRA advocates for the resort/gaming industry on legislation, regulations, and policies. The NRA represents 70 resort casinos across the state.

She formerly served as the Clark County CEO/Manager, the Las Vegas City Manager, and the first chief engineer/general manager of the Clark County Regional Flood Control District. She was previously employed by several top ENR engineering firms.

Ms. Valentine serves on several boards, including as a Director on the Nevada Transportation Board, chair of the Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department's Fiscal Affairs Committee, and is an employer trustee on the UniteHere Western Pension Fund. She formerly served on the Clark County Planning Commission, the Air Pollution Control Hearing Board, and National Board of Direction for the American Society of Civil Engineers.



She holds a Bachelor of Science degree in Civil Engineering and a Master of Public Administration. She is a registered professional engineer in Nevada and has been recognized by her alma mater in the Academy of Distinguished Engineers.

Her presentation covered a wide range of issues related to the resort industry and, as always, was received with great interest by our Southwest Rotarians. **Virginia** is widely known as a “person of impact in the community” and one who gets things done. Las Vegas is better for her dedicated service and contribution to the community.

Assembling Snack Kits and Feminine Hygiene Kits

The Rotary Club of Las Vegas Red Rock's first Epic Day of Service Event will take place on **Saturday, May 16, from 11:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.** at **Otonomus Hotel, 5050 W Russell Rd., Las Vegas, NV 89118**. During this time, Rotarians, community members, and corporate partners will come together to assemble **snack kits and feminine hygiene kits** that will be donated directly to the **Donna Street Community Center**, an organization dedicated to supporting and uplifting youth and families in our community.

Why are we assembling snack kits?

We desire to provide easy-to-grab snack kits for children who may not have consistent access to food at home. Each bag will include items such as Cup of Noodle soup, Capri Sun, fruit snacks, Slim Jims, granola bars, and other kid-friendly snacks. The cost of each snack kit will be approximately \$1.50. These snack kits will be distributed at the Donna Street Community Center, located in one of the most underserved areas of Las Vegas. Through this effort, Rotary Club of Las Vegas Red Rock is continuing to build a strong relationship with the Donna Street community by offering support and compassion. This project aims to bring comfort, hope, and nourishment to children—showing them that their community cares and that they are not forgotten.

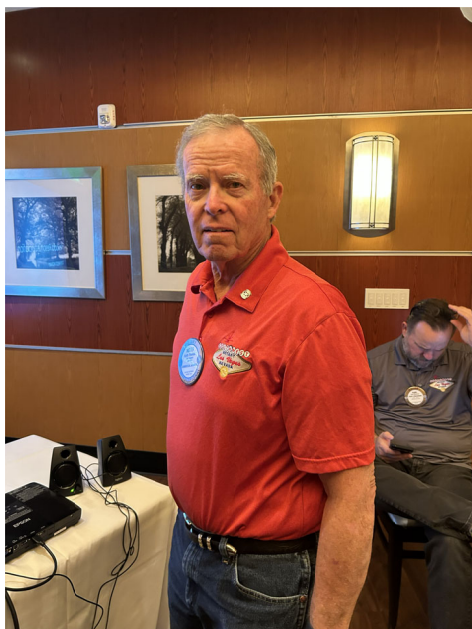
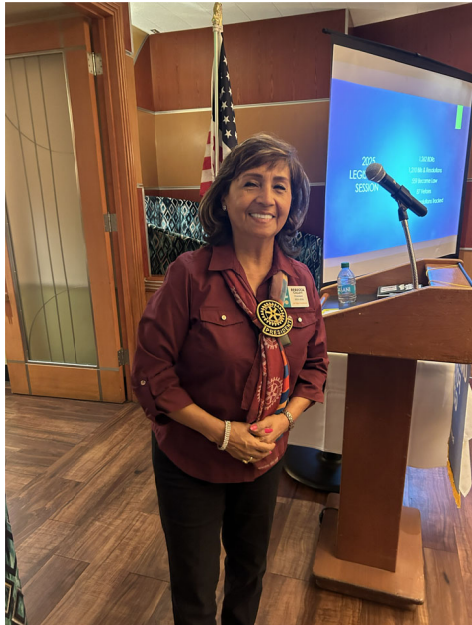
Why are we assembling feminine hygiene kits?

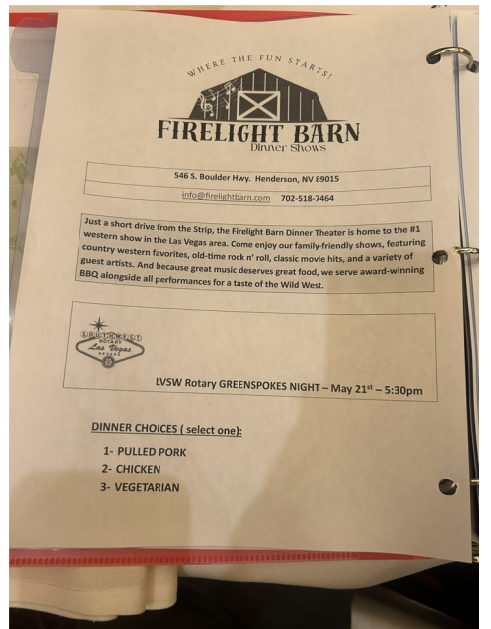
Access to menstrual products isn't a luxury—it's basic dignity and health. Each bag will include enough products for a menstrual cycle, including tampons (variety of sizes), pads (variety of sizes), panty-liners, individually wrapped flushable wipes, and chocolate. The cost of each feminine hygiene kit will be approximately \$3.50. We provide enough products for a full cycle because providing a few days' worth of products forces people to ration, improvise, or go without. A full cycle's supply aligns with the reality of menstrual cycles and prevents recurring crises. When products aren't available, people may use unsafe alternatives (paper products, cloth, prolonged use of the same item), increasing the risk of infections, rashes, and other health issues. A month's supply supports safe, hygienic use. Menstrual products are an ongoing expense that competes with food, rent, and utilities. A month's supply meaningfully eases financial strain instead of offering a short-term stopgap. Additionally, girls will avoid going to school if they do not have the necessary products.



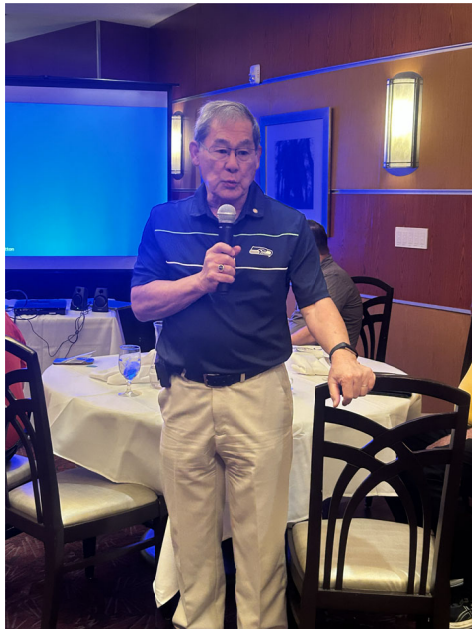

NRS 463.01865 “Resort hotel” defined. “Resort hotel” means any building or group of buildings that is maintained as and held out to the public to be a hotel where sleeping accommodations are furnished to the transient public and that has:

1. In a county whose population:
 - (a) Is 700,000 or more, more than 200 rooms available for sleeping accommodations; or
 - (b) Is 100,000 or more and less than 700,000, more than 300 rooms available for sleeping accommodations;
2. At least one bar with permanent seating capacity for more than 30 patrons that serves alcoholic beverages sold by the drink for consumption on the premises;
3. At least one restaurant with permanent seating capacity for more than 60 patrons that is open to the public 24 hours each day and 7 days each week; and
4. A gaming area within the building or group of buildings.
