ROTARIAN CODE OF CONDUCT

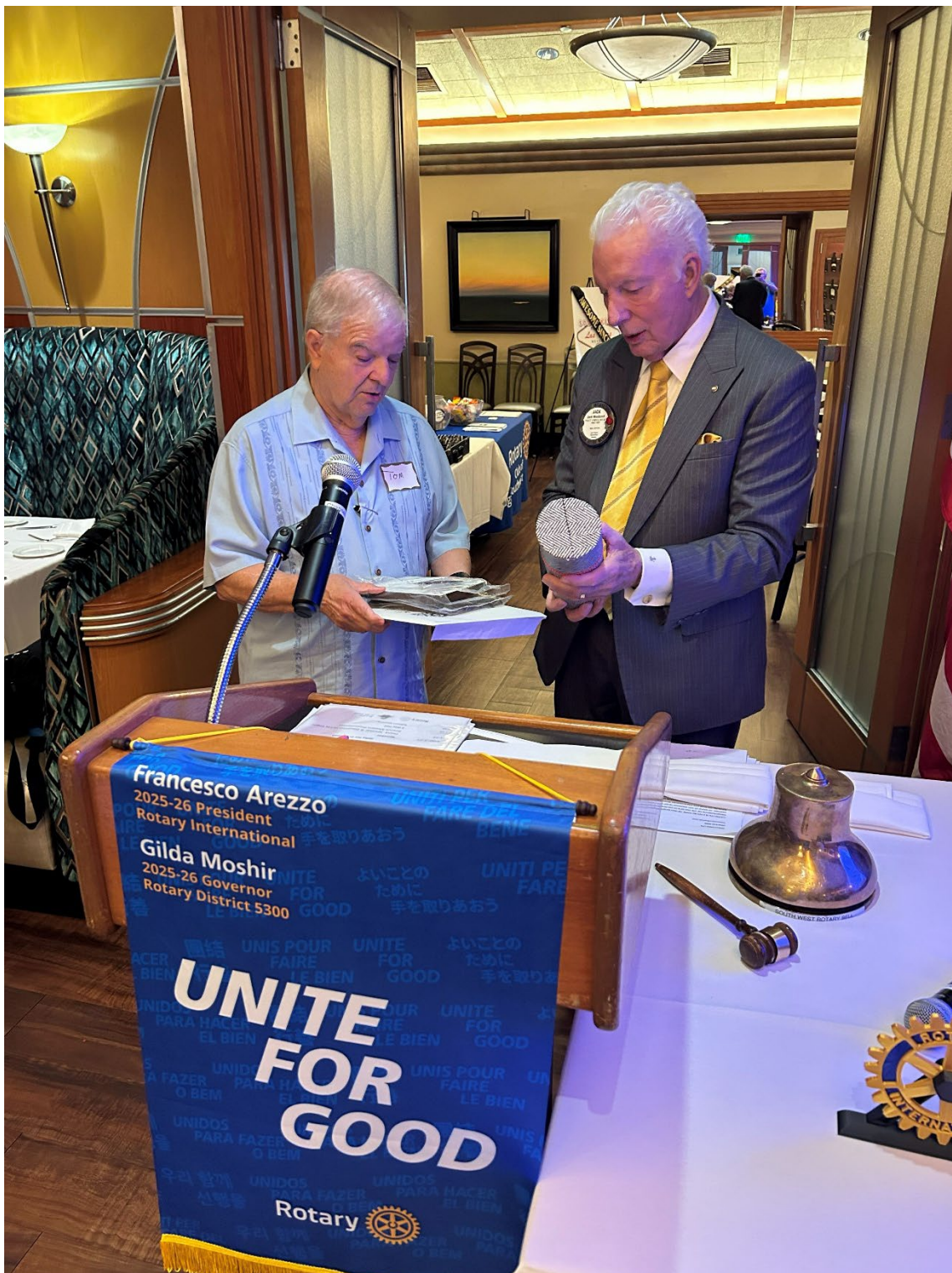
The following code of conduct has been adopted for the use of Rotarians:

John Bray, Corporate Director of Food & Beverage for [Stations Casinos](#) was our speaker today. He has been with Stations Casinos for 20 years. Click [here](#) to learn about the founding of Stations Casinos.

John gave us a very interesting recounting of how he made it to where he is, which demonstrates what can be accomplished when someone works hard, learns the business, and wants to get ahead.

His career began when in was still in high school when he started working at one of the biggest Denny's Restaurants around (Las Vegas Boulevard and Flamingo Rd.) From there his path traveled to the Mint, the Mirage, Mandalay Bay, Green Valley Ranch, and ultimately to his current position 8 years ago.

Frank Fertitta, Jr., originally opened what would become Palace Station on July 1, 1976, as The Casino, a 5,000-square-foot facility which offered 110 slot machines, five blackjack tables, and a snack bar just west of the Las Vegas Strip.

Station Casinos now owns and operates Red Rock Casino Resort Spa, Green Valley Ranch Resort Spa Casino, Durango Casino & Resort, Palace Station Hotel & Casino, Boulder Station Hotel & Casino, Santa Fe Station Hotel & Casino, Wildfire Rancho, Wildfire Valley View and & Hotel in Las Vegas, Nevada, Seventy Six Taverns in North Las Vegas and Sunset Station Hotel & Casino, Wildfire Anthem, Wildfire Boulder, Wildfire Lake Mead, Wildfire Sunset Casino and Seventy Six Tavern in Henderson, Nevada. Station Casinos also owns Barley's Casino & Brewing Company, The Greens and Wildfire Casino & Lanes in Henderson.

They are branching beyond the state and are working on an Indian Casino called North Fork in Madera, California (near Fresno).

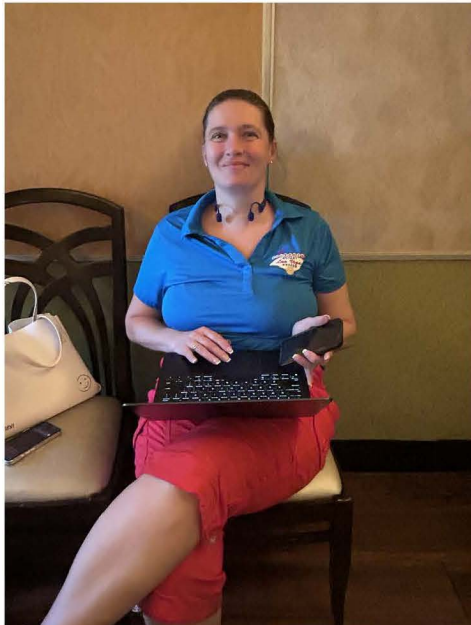

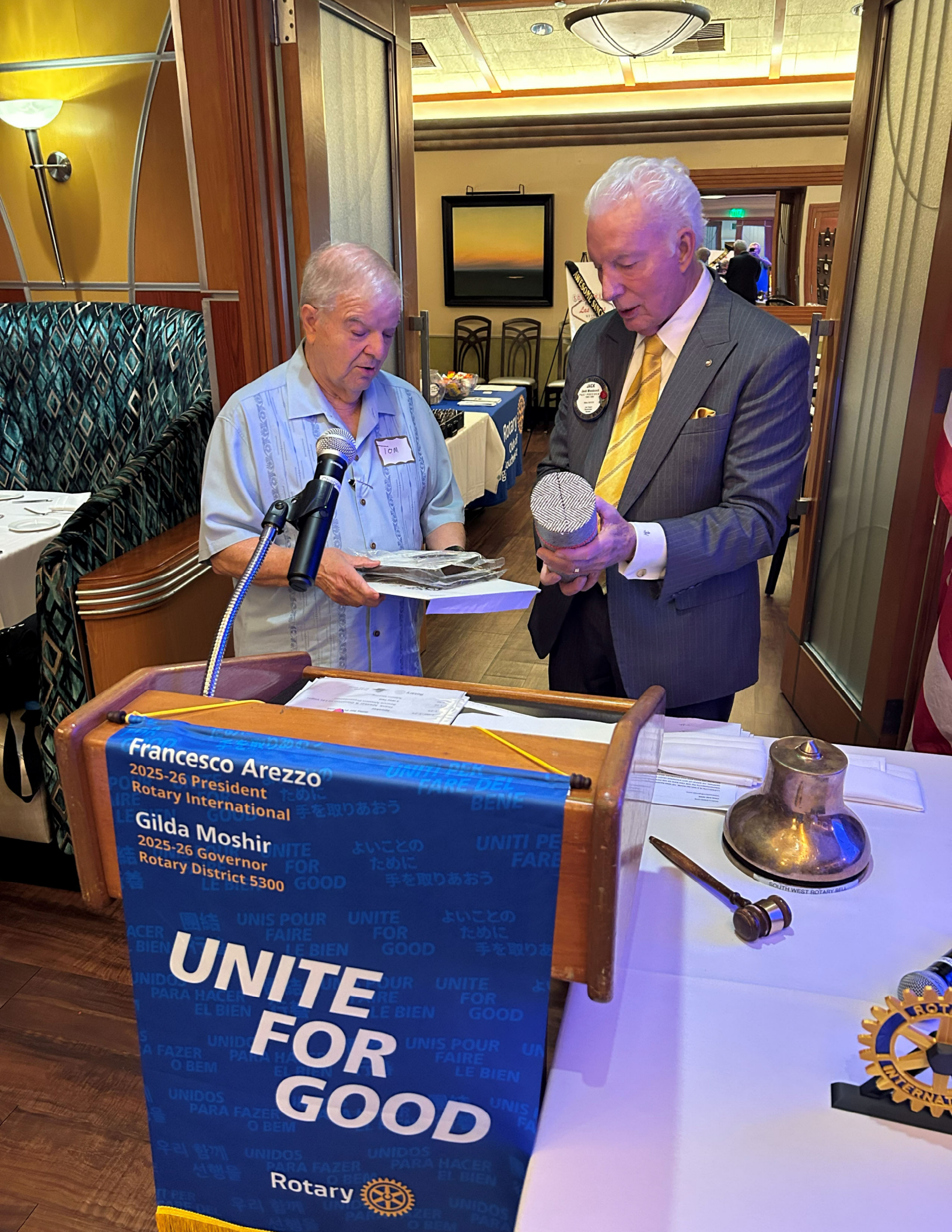

LLEWELLYN IS A WELSH NAME. HE WAS RAISED BY HIS MOM AND BOTH GRANDPARENTS ON THE ASH SIDE OF HIS FAMILY. HE THINKS ASH WAS GERMAN. HE GREW UP NOT KNOWING MUCH ABOUT THE WELSH SIDE BECAUSE HIS MOM AND DAD DIVORCED WHEN HE WAS 3 YEARS OLD. HE WAS BORN IN NORTHERN WEST VIRGINIA 90 MILES FROM PITTSBURG. WHEN HE WENT TO WORK IN SOUTHERN WEST VIRGINIA, HE LEARNED QUICKLY ONE HAS TO DEVELOP A WAY TO BE TRUSTED. HIS GRANDMA WAS THE MOST RELIGIOUS PERSON HE EVER KNEW. NO ONE EVER KNEW THAT, SHE JUST LIVED THAT WAY. HE FEELS SHE HAD THE MOST INFLUENCE ON HIM ALONG WITH HIS MOM. HIS MOM WAS THE CHURCH CHOIR DIRECTOR FOR 37(1/2) YEARS. SHE WAS VERY PROUD OF THE HALF. WHEN SHE LEFT, SHE WAS RELIEVED BUT WOULDN'T ADMIT IT. THESE WERE TWO STRONG INTELLEAGENT WOMAN. HE IS ALSO PROUD HE MARRIED A STRONG WOMAN AND RAISED ONE. HE STARTED COLLEGE AT BETHANY COLLEGE, A SMALL CHRISTIAN COLLEGE WHERE HIS GRANDMA AND ^{BROTHER} ~~MOM~~ WENT. HIS MOM OPTED OUT OF COLLEGE AND GOT MARRIED INSTEAD. HE WAS THERE FOR 1-1/2 YEARS BEFORE THE FAMILY RAN OUT OF MONEY. HE THEN WENT TO FAIRMONT STATE WHICH WAS MUCH CHEAPER. HE GRADUATED IN 1966 WITH A BS DEGREE IN BUSINESS. THE DAY AFTER HE GRADUATED, HE WENT TO WORK IN SOUTHERN WEST VIRGINIA AS A CHILD WELFARE WORKER. HE WAS THE

ONLY CHILDCARE WORKER IN THE ENTIRE COUNTY. THIS WAS TOTALLY DIFFERENT THAN WHAT HE WAS USED TO. IT WAS A VERY EYE-OPENING EXPERIENCE DEEP WITHIN THE COAL FIELDS. IT WAS GOOD FOR TOM TO LEARN SOMETHING ABOUT AN ECONOMY WHERE EVERYTHING DEPENDED ON THE PRICE OF COAL. THE ECONOMY CHANGED EVERY FEW YEARS AND EDUCATION WAS NOT AS VALUED AS WHERE HE WAS RAISED. HE TELLS THE STORY ABOUT TWO KIDS BEING BROUGHT BEFORE THE JUDGE FOR TRUANCY THAT LIVED WITHIN SIGHT OF THE SCHOOL. THE JUDGE ASKED THEIR FATHER WHY THE BOY AND GIRL WERE NOT GOING TO SCHOOL. THE FATHER SAID WELL... I CAN SEE WHERE MY BOY SHOULD LEARN SOMETHING, BUT THE ONLY THING MY GIRL NEEDS TO KNOW IS HOW TO MAKE BREAD AND MAKE BABIES. THIS WAS A WAKE-UP CALL FOR TOM. HIS LIFE EXPERIENCE TO DATE DID NOT INCLUDE THIS ATTITUDE. HE WAS ONLY 21 YEARS OLD AT THIS POINT. THE STATE KNEW THEY HAD TO HAVE MORE PEOPLE TO HELP THIS PART OF THEIR POPULATION SO THEY SENT HIM TO GRADUATE SCHOOL AT INDIANA UNIVERSITY SCHOOL OF SOCIAL WORK. THE BEST THING THAT HAPPENED THERE WAS HE MET SALLY. THEY HAVE BEEN MARRIED FOR 57 YEARS. SHE WAS THE ADMINISTRATOR OF A WOMEN AND CHILDRENS HOSPITAL IN CHARLESTON, WEST VIRGINIA WHEN SHE RETIRED IN 2007. IN HIS OPINION, SHE IS ELIGIBLE AND DESTINED FOR SAINT HOOD! ONE OF HIS MOST MEMORABLE EXPERIENCES WAS WHEN HE HAD TO DEAL WITH A CHILD WHO WAS ALWAYS IN TROUBLE AT A CHILD GUIDANCE CENTER. HE WAS ASSIGNED TO DEAL WITH THE PARENTS. A PSYCHIATRIST AND PSYCOLOGIST WERE ASSIGNED TO THE CHILD.

WHILE INTERVIEWING THE PARENTS, THE FATHER WAS A POLICE OFFICER IN UNIFORM WITH HIS REVOLVER ON HIS HIP. HE NOTICED THEY NEVER LOOKED AT EACH OTHER. WHEN TOM BROUGHT THIS TO THEIR ATTENTION, THEY GOT MAD AT HIM AND WERE ATTACKING EACH OTHER VERBALLY. IT WAS OBVIOUS THEY WERE THE PROBLEM AND NOT NECESSARILY THE CHILD. LATER, HIS BOSS SAID TO HIM "YOU REALLY KNOW HOW TO PICK A SCAB DON'T YOU". ONCE HE GRADUATED FROM GRAD SCHOOL, HIS ROLE CHANGED TO MANAGEMENT AND TRAINING. HE DREW FROM THE LESSONS HE LEARNED EARLY IN LIFE FROM HIS MOM AND GRANDMA EVERYDAY ABOUT THE DIFFERENCES OF HOW PEOPLE DELT WITH THE PROBLEMS THEY FACED. HIS CAREER WITH THE STATE CHANGED OVER THE YEARS. HE WORKED IN A VARIETY OF MANAGEMENT POSITIONS. TRAINING AS MENTIONED BEFORE WAS A BIG PART AS WELL AS MANAGING THE PERSONNEL FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN RESOUCES. THE BIGGEST JOB AND MOST ENJOYABLE WAS MANAGING THE DEVELOPMENT AND IMPLEMENTATION OF THE AUTOMATED "I T" SYSTEM. THIS HELPED BRING TO WEST VIRGINIA AUTOMATION TO THE CASH ASSISTANCE, FOOD STAMPS, AND MEDICAID PROGRAMS. THEY COMPLETED THE PROJECT ON TIME AND UNDER BUDGET. HE TELLS ME THIS WAS BECAUSE OF THE GREAT STAFF; HOWEVER, WE ALL KNOW THE IMPORTANCE OF GOOD LEADERSHIP! HE LOOKS BACK ON HIS CAREER WITH A GREAT DEAL OF SATISFACTION. HE, LIKE MOST OF US, DOESN'T MISS THE WORK, HE MISSES THE PEOPLE. HE RETIRED FROM THE STATE OF WEST VIRGINIA IN 1979. HE THEN WORKED AS A CONSULTANT FOR 10 YEARS HELPING OTHER STATES WITH WHAT

THEY HAD ACCOMPLISHED IN WEST VIRGINIA. TOM AND SALLY HAVE TWO CHILDREN, AMY AND JOE. AMY AND HER HUSBAND PAUL LIVE HERE IN LAS VEGAS AND HAVE TWO DAUGHTERS. ABBY IS ATTENDING UNIVERSITY OF DENVER MAJORING IN KINESIOLOGY. BECCA EARNED HER PRIVATE PILOTS LICENSE WHILE ATTENDING FAITH LUTHERAN. SHE WILL ATTEND THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH DAKOTA MAJORING IN FLIGHT IN THE FALL. AMY IS EMPLOYED AT MGM AND PAUL IS EMPLOYED AT TREASURE ISLAND. JOE AND HIS WIFE JENNIFER LIVE IN ELIZABETH PENNSYLVANIA. JOE WORKS FOR BETTIS CORPORATION AN "I T" CONTRACTOR. HE IS CURRENTLY ON A TEMPORARY ASSIGNMENT FOR A PROJECT IN AUSTRALIA. JENNIFER IS A STORE MANAGER FOR STARBUCKS. THEY HAVE ONE DAUGHTER, NICOLA. SHE WORKS FOR GOOGLE AND IS MARRIED TO AN ELECTRICIAN. HE AND SALLY MOVED TO LAS VEGAS IN 2008 WHEN THEIR YOUNGEST GRANDDAUGHTER BECCA WAS BORN. THEY LIVED IN THE SAME HOUSE FROM 2008 UNTIL 5 MONTHS AGO WHEN THEY MOVED INTO LAS VENTANAS.
